Re: NMLSR Mortgage Loan Originator Job Analysis Survey

On behalf of the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System and Registry (NMLSR), the department is inviting you and mortgage loan originators in your company to participate in an important survey. The results of the survey will be used to help develop the SAFE Mortgage Loan Originator Test, one of the requirements of the SAFE Mortgage Licensing Act which became law in July, 2008.

The Mortgage Loan Originator (MLO) Job Analysis Survey is being conducted to collect information about the knowledge required to perform as an MLO. The findings of the survey will be used as the foundation for the planned National and State Components of the SAFE Mortgage Test. The success of the survey will depend on the cooperation of a large number of industry professionals, representing all geographic parts of the country, and working in all segments of mortgage loan origination. In addition, mortgage regulators from our agency and across the country will be taking the survey too.

Details about the survey are as follows:

- The survey will take approximately 30 minutes to complete.
- It is conducted electronically through a secure application on the web.
