




### Number of Mortgage Bankers and Branches






#### Number of Mortgage Companies and Branches





### Number of Residential Mortgage Loan Originators


Number of Texas-licensed Residential Mortgage Loan Originators 5-Year History as Fiscal Year End (08/31)






### New License Requests Received

### 2026 Renewal Period

- Renewal Period will run from November 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025
- Check your NMLS record for Outstanding License Items
- RMLO's must complete Continuing Education prior to filing a Renewal Request
- MU1's need to file MCRs (including the MCR Statement of Condition) prior to filing a Renewal Request
- File a Renewal Request as soon as possible
- Residential Mortgage Servicers should convert Paper Surety Bonds to Electronic Surety Bonds (ESB).



## New in Licensing

- As of January 1, 2026, SML will no longer accept Paper Surety Bonds for Residential Mortgage Servicers Registrations per 7 Texas Administrative Code § 58.107,

#### Companies (MU1)

- Issues with the entity's Texas Secretary of State registration
- Company name does not match IRS Documents



### **Outstanding License Items**

#### RMLO (MU4)

- Employment History does not match State Relationships
- Not providing documentation and/or explanations for the Disclosure Questions that have been answered as a "Yes".
- Issues with Mailing and Residential Addresses
- Paying NMLS fees with an ACH
